

Amendment #3

3.1.A Race Committee Volunteering - Volunteering for Race Committee is an essential part of the Race Program and scheduled races cannot proceed without it. All boats are expected to participate in providing a crew for the Race Committee for the series the boat is participating in (eg Wednesday Series A crew for a Wed Series A race). The crew will be a minimum of 3 people who will be either on a mark boat or Oyster. The specific crew assignments will be determined either by the Race Officer for that race or the Race Director.

Boats who provide a crew meeting the above requirements will be scored for that race using their average finish position for that series rounded up or down to the nearest whole number (eg $3.5.\text{avg} = 3$, $3.51 = 4$) provided the boat did not race. If a boat provides a crew as above and also races in that particular race, its actual finish for that race will be its score. If a boat does not provide a crew as above, no credit is given. Any boat signing up for a particular week and not providing a crew as above will be scored as DSQ for that race.

Boats are encouraged to use the Race Committee signup page in the OYS Volunteering section and are asked to note the number of crew who will be participating. Boats not volunteering for a specific week will be assigned at the discretion of the Race Director.
