### 1. RULES

**1.1** The Regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017 – 2020 (RRS) and the prescriptions of the Sail Canada, except as altered by the Sailing Instructions.

### 2. COURSE and CLASSES

- **2.1** One course featuring handicap racing for keelboats, with multiple classes for both Spinnaker and Non-Flying-Sails racers. There will be one-design racing for Sharks and any other one-design fleet for which there is a sufficient number of entries, plus a "Cruising Class" for boats that do not race regularly. The Organizing Authority will assign a handicap rating to boats in the Cruising division.
- **2.2** The Course will be described in the Sailing Instructions. Any changes will be announced at the Skipper's Meeting.
- 2.3 First Warning Gun at 10:55am

### 3. CONDITIONS OF ENTRY and INSURANCE

- **3.1** All boats in the handicap classes (except for those in the "Cruising Class" start) must hold a valid PHRF-LO certificate.
- **3.2** Each participating boat must carry valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum limit of \$2,000,000.00.

**4.1** Saturday following the race, there will be a Culinary Tastings Experience, Complimentary Beer and Wine (while quantities last), Cash Bar, Live Band, Live and Silent auctions, Awards. Venue: Oakville Yacht Squadron
