## RACE COMMITTEE DUTY POLICIES

March 16, 2022

The OYS Race Management Group recognizes that boats have a limited sailing season and want to make the most out of every day on the water. To ensure our Club Racing program has an ample supply of volunteer Race Committee staff the following policies are mandated.

- OYS and OC racers will be able to sign up for Duty Sessions for all races Organized by OYS.
- Prior to the season all registered boats shall sign up for 2 Race Committee Duty sessions.
- A Race Committee duty session will consist of providing 2 able bodies for a race.
- There will be two duty sessions available per weeknight (Tuesday or Thursday) race.
- Duty sessions for weekend races are to be determined and will be communicated at a future date.
- A web-based calendar will be provided on the OYS website showing available duty sessions.
- Boats can coordinate with each other if they wish to swap duty sessions. Confirmation of duty session swaps shall be communicated to Karen Wykes, [karenwykes@oysqn.com](mailto:karenwykes@oysqn.com) at least 48 hours in advance.
- A boat is scored as RCD during a race committee duty session. RCD shall be the average of a boats non-excluded scores for a series.
- A boat that misses their scheduled race committee duty session shall be scored as DNE in the median race of the series in which they complete the most races.
- Boats that have not signed up for their 2 duty sessions by May 10 will be assigned slots by the race committee.
- Race Committee duty sessions performed by OYS members may be used to satisfy a member's volunteer hours requirement.
